PART OF TOULOUSE CAPITOLE UNIVERSITY

The University Institute of Rodez is part of Toulouse Capitole University. Its purpose is to train high school graduates for professional life.

The IUT delivers university instruction in 2 years with students obtaining a Diplôme Universitaire de Technologie, or a 3-year Licence (equivalent to Bachelor's degree).

The curriculum is integrated into the European LMD scheme : Licence – Master – Doctorat, equivalent to Bachelor – Master – PhD, which allows you to pursue studies at College or in business schools or engineering schools.

Whether you are in **initial training**, **continuous education** or **apprenticeship**, everything is organised so that you receive quality and adapted training.

Throughout the program, you will get support from lecturers and teachers, professionals and administrative staff.

THE DUT - TWO-YEAR TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY DEGREES

The DUT is a selective 2-year professional degree. It offers in-depth professional training through a technological approach combining both theory and practice.

Courses consist of:

- › **20 %** lecture & theory
- › **50 %** tutorial and practice
- › **30 %** projects and internships

Skills assessments are carried out regularly throughout the 2-year program. After graduating, you can either search for a job or continue studying.

THE LICENCE PROFESSIONNELLE - VOCATIONAL BACHELOR'S DEGREE

An additional one-year follow-up degree in a related area will give you even higher professional qualifications. Each Licence Professionnelle is developed in partnership with local companies, thus providing a convenient work-study experience.

THE LICENCE GÉNÉRALE - ACADEMIC BACHELOR

Or, after a two-year degree in a related area, you can also continue your college training and aim for a Master's degree. In this case, you will start with a one-year Licence Générale (Academic Bachelor) specializing in one theoretical field, and then follow that up with two more years at Toulouse University, which will then lead you to achieve a Master's degree (5 years total).



Organization

About 30 hours of class time per week, including lectures, tutorials and workshops or practicals

Supervised projects in groups of 3 or 4: hands-on approach through real working life practice

Continuous assessment and end-of-semester examinations

Teachers and final-year student mentorship

Compulsory attendance

THE LIBRARY (CRDOC)

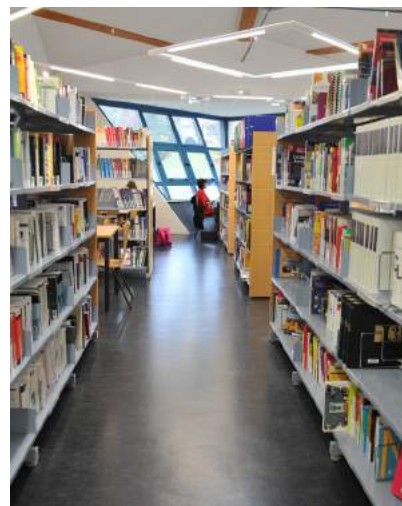
The library's mission is to provide students and teaching staff with the necessary documentation and content for teaching and research study. Admission and borrowing rights are free for on-site reading and research, but also for group work. You may also borrow books, DVDs and magazines.

The library resources are built around the courses' contents, with collections consisting of over 7000 books, 52 magazine subscriptions, DVDs etc.

The collection also includes digital resources. You can even have remote access to electronic magazines, e-books and databases from home. Moreover, you can borrow novels and films.

12 computer workstations as well as one printer and one scanner are available within the library

FACILITIES

There are 12 computer rooms over the campus. Each of them is equipped with 28 workstations operating on both Windows and Linux with :

- › Broadband internet access ;
- › Regular software and hardware updates ;
- › Wireless network.

In addition to that, audiovisual equipment is made available to the students upon request :

- › 4 video cameras ;
- › 1 camcorder ;
- › Several digital cameras.

In addition, the campus also features :

- › **1 amphitheater** seating 220 for lectures and conferences ;
- › **1 technological hall** specifically designed for quality-related workshops, industrial logistics activities and computer-aided design ;
- › **2 Learning Labs** ;
- › **2 multimedia labs** available for language courses.



BEING A STUDENT IN RODEZ

The Student Life service (Vie Etudiante) is here to answer your questions about accommodations, food and leisure activities.

HOUSING

You can find accommodation that's right for you by consulting offers with the many real estate agencies, residence halls, hostels or in the private housing market. Most furnished flats or studios are a 10-minute walk from the University Institute.

TRANSPORT

The combined train & bus station is a 5-minute walk from the Institute campus, and students are entitled to discounts. For information, contact the SNCF (national railway service). It's easy to get around Rodez thanks to the large bus network and the variety of ticket options and passes, including student fares. For example, for travels within Rodez, the Agglobus local network offers the annual Pass-Jeune.

CATERING

The University restaurant Camonil is close to the University Institute and available to students from Monday to Friday 11.00 am to 2.30 pm. There,

you can enjoy a 3-course meal at the low price of only €3.25 (2019 prices). Menus can be checked beforehand on the town hall website. However, if you prefer to have lunch within the University Institute, the student recreation room offers a friendly relaxation area equipped with microwave ovens, several tables and a kitchen sink.

LEISURE TIME ACTIVITIES

Aveyron is a rich area in terms of tourism and culture. Many events (festivals, concerts, exhibitions, theatre performances etc) are available at affordable student prices. For music and drama lovers, entertainment venues such as L'Amphithéâtre, La Baleine, Le Krill, Le Club and the MJC's youth acidity center offer selective programming. If you'd rather just go to see a movie, the CGR cinema is located within walking distance of the University Institute.



Three museums offer permanent and temporary exhibitions in Rodez : Denys Puech Museum (fine arts), Fenaille Museum (history and archeology) and Soulages Museum (paintings).

You can ask for the ZAP card and coupon book, which offer reductions on a wide variety of goods and services throughout Rodez and neighbouring towns.

Aveyron also provides a wide range of activities for sport enthusiasts, from relaxed & conventional to extreme : mountain biking, skiing, canoeing, climbing, paragliding etc. Students can thus enjoy a healthy work-life balance and release pressure by working out.

The local student sport association ASUR (Association Sportive Universitaire Ruthénoise) supports students' initiatives for sports and cultural projects, by facilitating access to recreational or competitive activities such as handball, volleyball, badminton, indoor football, boxing, vo-Vietnam, taï-jutsi...)
